This meeting will take place online, <u>not</u> in person at the Halls Creek Civic Hall. The notice sent to Ngarrawanji native title holders on 11 February 2022 stated that this meeting would take place at the Halls Creek Civic Hall. Due to the risk of COVID-19 in the Kimberley region, this meeting will no longer take place in person at the Halls Creek Civic Hall, and will be held online instead. Details of how to join the online meeting are contained in this notice.

# What decisions will be made at this meeting?

# 1 PBC nomination:

Do Ngarrawanji native title holders want to instruct the Kimberley Land Council to nominate an Aboriginal Corporation to be the Ngarrawanji PBC?

If the answer to this question is 'yes', the next part of the meeting will be a pre-incorporation meeting to establish a new corporation to be the PBC and the questions in 2 below will need to be answered. If the answer to this question is 'no' the ILSC will be the PBC and the meeting can go straight to question 3.

# **2** Pre-incorporation meeting:

If the answer to question 1 is 'yes', the meeting will need to make the following decisions.

2.1 Who are the initial (first) members of the new corporation?

Anyone who wants to be an initial member must provide written consent.

2.2 Is the PBC rulebook approved?

The KLC will review and provide advice on a draft rulebook. The draft rulebook includes some rules that must be included and some rules that members will need to make decisions about.

2.3 Who are the initial (first) directors of the corporation?

Anyone who wants to be an initial director must provide a written consent.


- 2.4 Who is the contact person for the corporation?
- 2.5 Who is authorised to submit the application for registration to ORIC?

### 3. Future Acts Instructions:

Ngarrawanji native title holders should provide instructions to the PBC (the ILSC or their own corporation) for future acts.

The meeting is being held in accordance with Federal Court orders made on 10 December 2021 This is an important meeting for Ngarrawanji Native Title Holders to attend and make decisions about the Ngarrawanji Prescribed Body Corporate (PBC). If Ngarrawanji Native Title Holders don't establish a Ngarrawanji PBC at this meeting, the Indigenous Land and Sea Corporation (ILSC) will become the Ngarrawanji PBC.

The area of the Ngarrawanji determination is shown outlined in blue on the map below. The area of the Ngarrawanji #2 determination is shown outlined in black on the map below.



# Who can attend the meeting?

The meeting is being held for **Ngarrawanji Native Title Holders**. The Ngarrawanji Native Title Holders are those Aboriginal people who:

- (a) are related through filiation (including by adoption) to one of the Ngarrawanji Apical Ancestors who held rights and interest in one of the local estate countries comprising the Ngarrawanji Determination Area; or
- (b) are affiliated to a Ngarrawanji Apical Ancestor and who have spirit conception and/or birth sites in one of the local estate countries in the Ngarrawanji Determination Area; or
- (c) are recognised by the persons described above as:
  - (i) holding rights and responsibilities for certain songs and ceremonies which make reference to important sites in the Ngarrawanji Determination Area; or
  - (ii) holding rights and interests in one of the local estate countries in the Ngarrawanji Determination Area under traditional law and custom.
